## 2+2 Articulation Agreement for students transferring from TULSA COMMUNITY COLLEGE (TCC) to OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY (OSU) **DEPARTMENT OF NUTRITIONAL SCIENCES (NSCI)**

(Option: Community Nutrition)

Applies only to students matriculating Academic Year 2016-2017

This curriculum identifies courses to be taken at TCC that are equivalent to or will substitute for required courses counting toward the major in Nutritional Sciences, option in Community Nutrition, at OSU (2016-2017 OSU NSCI/Community Nutrition degree sheet only). It assumes that the student will start in the Fall semester. Careful attention must be paid to the sequencing of courses offered only in the Fall and Spring.

# \*Community Nutrition Emphases - Controlled electives will be used for Emphasis courses. Student should work with adviser to develop Emphasis.

Nutrition & Exercise (NUEX): Includes prerequisites for MS in Athletic Training HHP 2654, 2802, 3114, 3663, 4773 PHYS 1114, MATH 1613 or 1715, plus 2-4 hours Controlled Electives <u>Nutrition Education (NUED)</u>: Student must declare a minor in HEPR. HHP 2213, 2603, 2654, 3114, 3613, 3643, 4973 plus 4 hours Controlled Electives <u>School Nutrition & Food Service Management (SNFSM)</u>:

HRAD 2283, 3473, 3623, 3783, 4213, MICR 2123, 2132, MKTG 3213, NSCI 4331, 4573

Food, Nutrition, & the Public (FNP): Select 27 hours of Controlled Electives working with adviser to identify courses which support the NSCI major and a clearly articulated career path. This may be accomplished by the addition of an OSU minor. Career paths may include: Cooperative Extension, Food Sales, Public Policy, Communications, International Nutrition. Plan must be approved by department head.

## **Oklahoma State University Bachelor of Science Degree Requirements**

- Required for graduation at OSU: (1) minimum 2.50 GPA overall with a minimum 2.50 GPA in all courses in College/Departmental and Major, (2) a grade of "C" or better is required in all NSCI 3000- and 4000-level courses, (3) 40 Upper- Division hours, (4) 60 hours must be completed at a four-year institution, (5) at least 30 hours completed at OSU, 15 of the final 30 or 50% of the upper-division hours in the major field completed at OSU. Limit of: one-half of major course requirements as transfer work; one-fourth of hours earned by correspondence; 8 transfer correspondence hours.
- Students will be held responsible for degree requirements in effect at the time of matriculation (date at first enrollment) and any changes that are made, so long as these changes do not result in semester credit hours being added or do not delay graduation.

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- Student must take enough upper division controlled electives to meet the 40 upper-division hour requirement. Twenty-seven hours of controlled electives must be taken in addition to the specified major requirements to meet the 69 hour major requirement.
- This degree program does not meet all of the Didactic Program in Dietetics Academic Course Requirements. See the Dietetics option sheet for courses to be added.
