Memorandum of Understanding

Degree Completion Transfer Agreement Between

Tulsa Community College and the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville

This Memorandum of Agreement (hereinafter "Agreement") is made and entered into by and between Tulsa Community College (hereinafter TCC) and the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville (hereinafter UAF), which have agreed to cooperate for the purpose of assisting TCC graduates to complete the appropriate designated bachelor's degree from those listed below from UAF. It is the purpose of the Agreement to offer students a seamless option for the completion of the appropriate bachelor's degree. Through collaborative efforts, both institutions desire to increase graduation rates, facilitate the transfer process, and maintain a high-quality working relationship between the two institutions.

UAF Degrees

Candidates from TCC are eligible to seek the following degree from UAF. The intent is that the College of Education and Health Professions will expand these offerings in the near future.

Bachelor of Science in Education in Human Resource and Workforce Development Education (online)

Agreement

- Satisfactory completion of the Enterprise Development Associate in Science degree (the degree
 includes the minimum of 35-hour state general education core) will be accepted as satisfying the
 UAF COEHP general education core requirements. A student who holds the Enterprise
 Development Associate in Science degree and has completed courses required for the HRWD
 degree will be accepted for transfer into the HRWD degree program with Junior classification,
 subject to the following conditions:
- 2. The UAF operates under a selective admissions policy. Transferring students are subject to all procedures relative to this policy. These procedures are available on the UAF Admission website.
- 3. All courses taken to satisfy the Associate's degree at TCC must have a grade of "C" or higher in order for the credits to transfer to UAF for articulation.
- 4. TCC will use best efforts to inform students of the transferability of the Associate's degree to UAF. Statements about this transfer agreement will also appear in the TCC catalog and on the TCC website.
- 5. Both institutions will notify the corresponding institution in a timely manner of substantial changes in their curricula.
- 6. The UAF COEHP will provide TCC with current copies of catalogs/curricular requirements as they are available.
- 7. The BSE in HRWD degree offered by UAF will be offered in a completely online format.
- 8. Information regarding transfer scholarships will be made available to students while attending TCC.
