





PROGRAM ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

In accordance with the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education policy 3.11.4, this agreement will be subject to the following provisions:

1. The student shall have graduated from Tulsa Community College (TCC) with an Associate in Science in Business Administration degree with a total of 60 credit hours (excluding zero-level classes and physical education activity courses).
2. Completion of at least 33 semester hours at Oklahoma Baptist University out of the last 64 semester hours are required for the degree. A minimum of 50% of hours completed toward the major must be completed in residence and at least 39 hours must be at the 3000/4000 level.
3. Provided the student follows the sequence of both the associate degree program and the baccalaureate degree program, the student will be able to complete the baccalaureate degree program in 128 credit hours, the same number as required for a native student.
4. The student shall have earned a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale (an average grade of "C" or better) at Tulsa Community College.
5. Each institution will consult the other institution when considering curriculum changes which will impact this articulation agreement.

Upon formal approval of this articulation agreement by the appropriate officials of the two institutions, each is free to publicize the terms herein. This agreement shall be effective for students matriculating during the 2017-2018 academic year and will remain in effect for subsequent academic years until one or both of the institutions deem it necessary to modify or terminate the agreement.
