Milestones and Recommended Actions - TCC:

- **Faculty Advisement:** Meet with a Human Services faculty member early in your academic career and each semester to address your career interests and plan your degree path.
- Consider Summer Courses: Summer courses at TCC can help accelerate your time to transfer, and help you stay
 on track. Talk to your advisor about planning summer courses.
- During or After Year One at TCC: Consider a campus tour of Northeastern State University and connect with a NSU
 academic advisor, to ensure you are on track to transfer. Your TCC academic advisor can assist in planning these
 actions.
- **During Year Two at TCC:** After semester three coursework, apply for admission at Northeastern State University as a transfer student (https://apply.nsuok.edu/).
- **Final Semester at TCC:** Congratulations you are about to earn your Associate's Degree. Be sure to apply for graduation @ https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation.
- Transcripts: submit official TCC transcript to NSU (<u>www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/student-records/requesting-and-submitting-transcripts</u>).
- Reverse Transfer: If you have not earned an Associate in Arts or an Associate in Science from TCC, and have
 completed 60 credit hours, with 15 of those hours completed at TCC, email reversetransfer@tulsacc.edu to see if you
 qualify for a degree through the Reverse Transfer program.

Program Information and Recommended Actions - NSU:

- Students will need to submit their application to the BSW practicum after completing all general education requirements as well as the following courses:
 - SOC 1113 Introduction to Sociology/ PSYC 1113 Introduction to Psychology/ SOWK 2013 Introduction to Social Work (Principles of Human Services)/ SOWK 4003 HBSE I (Lifespan Development)/ SOWK 4613 Human Diversity/ SOWK 3013 Interviewing Skills/ BIOL 1114 Biology with Lab/ SOC 3323 Social Statistics/ MATH 1313 Elementary Statistics or MATH 1473 Applied Mathematics or MATH 1513 College Algebra or MATH 1523 Functions and Change COMM 1113 Fundamentals of Oral Communication
- Also, applicants must be enrolled or have completed the following courses at that time of practicum application submission. Students must have completed 88 hours prior to beginning Practicum.
 - SOWK 4873 HBSE II/ 4013 Practice I/ 4863 Social Policy/ 4643 Case Management
- Applicants must have earned a cumulative GPA of 2.50 on a 4.00 scale

- The deadline for the Practicum Application is March 1 (of the junior year).

Baccalaureate Degree Information:

- Students must complete 60 of 124 credit hrs. from a university (four-year school), excluding physical educ. courses.
- 30 credit hours are required from NSU.
- 40 credit hours must be junior and senior (3000/4000) level courses.
- At least 18 hrs., or 50% of the major, whichever is greater, must be from NSU; half the major must be upper level (3000/4000).



- English proficient (ENGL 1113 Composition & ENGL 1213 Composition II) with a C or better.
- Computer proficient.
