

Note: TCC Communication courses will count towards RSU's Communication's program common core courses, Broadcasting and New Media option, or free electives.

A minor requires completion of at least 18-24 designated credit hours of coursework outside the student's major field, including a minimum of 9 upper-division credit hours, and may have a required core. The same courses many are not used to fulfill the requirements for both a major and a minor. To complete a minor, a student is required to earn six 3000-4000 level credit hours in that minor at RSU (Rogers State Bulletin 2021-2022 p.87).

If you choose an approved minor (18-24 hours) you must select 9 hours of communication electives. However, if you do not choose a minor you will select 27 hours from the list of approved communications electives.

TCC Milestones and Recommended Actions:

- **Consider Summer Courses:** Summer courses at TCC can help accelerate your time to transfer, and help you stay on track. Talk to your advisor about planning summer courses.
- **During or After Year One at TCC:** Consider a campus tour of Rogers State University and connect with an RSU academic advisor, to ensure you are on track to transfer. Your TCC academic advisor can assist in planning these actions.



- During Year Two at TCC: During or after semester three coursework, apply for admission at Rogers State University as a transfer student (<u>www.rsu.edu/admissions/admission-requirements/transfer-students/</u>).
- Final Semester at TCC: Congratulations you are about to earn your Associate in Comm. Art and Technologies, Mass Comm: Electronic & Broadcast Comm. Option. Be sure to apply for graduation @ https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation.
- **Transcripts:** Submit an official TCC transcript to RSU (<u>www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/student-</u>
- **Reverse Transfer:** If you have not earned an Associate in Arts or an Associate in Science from TCC, and have completed 60 credit hours, with 15 of those hours completed at TCC, email <u>reversetransfer@tulsacc.edu</u> to see if you qualify for a degree through the Reverse Transfer program.
