<u>\*NOTE:</u> Students can choose to begin the foreign language sequence at TCC with open electives, but should be aware this option will increase the overall credit hours for completion. Discuss the best option for planning your foreign language courses with your academic advisor or send questions to the TU Center for Academic Advising (advising@utulsa.edu).

### **TU Tuition Costs:**

Full-time students pay a flat tuition rate each semester they are enrolled in 12 - 18 hours. Any semester where a student is enrolled in 11 hours or less is billed per semester hour. Any semesters with an approved overload above 18 hours has additional tuition costs on top of the flat tuition rate to cover the additional hours. Tuition costs and associated student fees are posted online at <u>Tuition & Costs - The University of Tulsa (utulsa.edu)</u>. The degree map above has been divided to maximize enrollment versus tuition cost each semester. Students that choose to enroll in fewer than 12 hours or more than 18 hours in any particular semester should be prepared for different tuition costs.

#### **TCC Milestones and Recommended Actions:**

- **Consider Summer Courses:** Summer courses at TCC can help accelerate your time to transfer, and help you stay on track. Talk to your advisor about planning summer courses.
- **During or After Year One at TCC:** Consider a campus tour of University of Tulsa and connect with a TU academic advisor, to ensure you are on track to transfer. Your TCC academic advisor can assist in planning these actions.
- **During Year Two at TCC:** After semester three coursework, apply for admission at University of Tulsa as a transfer student (<u>https://admission.utulsa.edu/apply/transfer-applicants/</u>).



- **Final Semester at TCC:** Congratulations you are about to earn your A.A. in Art. Be sure to apply for graduation @ <u>https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation</u>.
- **Transcripts:** Submit an official TCC transcript to TU (<u>www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/student-r</u>
- Reverse Transfer: If you have not earned an Associate in Arts or an Associate in Science from TCC, and have completed 60 credit hours, with 15 of those hours completed at TCC, email <u>reversetransfer@tulsacc.edu</u> to see if you qualify for a degree through the Reverse Transfer program.

# **TU Program Information:**

- All transfer students to the studio art program must submit a portfolio of work for review by the faculty member in the area of emphasis, and acceptance is based on that portfolio review. Transfer equivalencies listed as part of the first two years are not guaranteed to apply towards studio art major requirements until a portfolio has been reviewed and approved.
- Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 in the Area of Concentration (Major and Minor subjects) and a minimum of 2.0 TU GPA.
- No Pass/D/F or CLEP credit may be applied toward the Area of Concentration (Major and Minor subjects).
- This degree has a required Minor in Art History.
- Courses applied to meet Core and General Curriculum requirements may not also apply in your Major or Minor subjects.
- Two thirds of the course work in the Major subject must be at the 3000 or 4000 level.
- TU will waive FYE 1001, AS 2001, and FS 1973 required for degree completion if student follows the mapped courses. However, if the student doesn't follow the course map as outlined they could be required to take FYE 1001, AS 2001, and FS 1973.
- In meeting the block requirements, a student may take no more than two courses from a single discipline.
- No more than nine hours in ART may be earned in addition to the indicated major subject requirements. This number may be exceeded only by increasing the number of hours beyond the 120 required for graduation.
- Two courses must be taken to meet the HCGD requirement. The HCGD requirement can be fulfilled with courses in the major, minor, general curriculum, or general electives.
