To take these courses at TCC, students should confirm with their advisors that the course/s will fit into the associate degree without exceeding the requirements. A minimum of 60 hours must be taken at a baccalaureate granting institution. Exceeding 64 credit hours at the community college means the student will be required to take more than the minimum of 124 credit hour total. A minimum of 40 hours of 3/4000 level courses is required for the baccalaureate. Courses from community colleges are 1/2000 level.
