#### **TU Tuition Costs:**

• Full-time students pay a flat tuition rate each semester they are enrolled in 12 - 18 hours. Any semester where a student is enrolled in 11 hours or less is billed per semester hour. Any semesters with an approved overload above 18 hours has additional tuition costs on top of the flat tuition rate to cover the additional hours. Tuition costs and associated student fees are posted online at <u>Tuition & Costs - The University of Tulsa (utulsa.edu)</u>. The degree map above has been divided to maximize enrollment versus tuition cost each semester. Students that choose to enroll in fewer than 12 hours or more than 18 hours in any particular semester should be prepared for different tuition costs.

#### **Milestones and Recommended Actions:**

- During Year One at TCC: Consider a campus tour of University of Tulsa and connect with a TU academic advisor, to ensure you are on track to transfer. Your TCC academic advisor can assist in planning these actions.
  - o TCC students following this plan should apply to the TU BSN program during the first year at TCC, between November 1<sup>st</sup> and February 1<sup>st</sup> (<a href="https://admission.utulsa.edu/apply/transfer-applicants/">https://admission.utulsa.edu/apply/transfer-applicants/</a>).
- **Final Semester at TCC:** Congratulations you are about to earn you're A.S. in Pre-Nursing! Be sure to apply for graduation @ <a href="https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation">https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation</a>.
- **Transcripts:** Submit an official TCC transcript to TU (<u>www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/student-records/requesting-and-submitting-transcripts</u>).
- Reverse Transfer: If you have not earned an Associate in Science from TCC, and have completed 60 credit hours, with 15 of those hours completed at TCC, contact <a href="mailto:reversetransfer@tulsacc.edu">reversetransfer@tulsacc.edu</a> to see if you qualify for a degree through the Reverse Transfer program.

#### **Additional Program Information:**

- Admission to the University of Tulsa School of Nursing is competitive; on time completion of pre-requisites and program application is critical.
- All degree applicable transfer courses must be completed with a C or better.
- The TU BSN program is a full-time, integrated BSN program with 5 semesters of clinical coursework.
- TCC courses should be taken in the order they are planned to ensure that students can progress in TU coursework as planned in this degree map.
- TCC students following this plan should apply to the TU BSN program during the first year at TCC, between November 1<sup>st</sup> and February 1<sup>st</sup> (<a href="https://admission.utulsa.edu/apply/transfer-applicants/">https://admission.utulsa.edu/apply/transfer-applicants/</a>).
- TU BSN Program Admission Requirements
  - Must have a cumulative grade-point average of 3.0
  - Must have completed BIOL 2134 Human Anatomy and BIOL 2154 Human Physiology within the past five years with a "C" or higher
  - All science courses need to have been taken within the last 5 years, and be approved by our Director, in order to transfer to the nursing program
  - Prospective nursing students whose first language is not English must have a minimum TOEFL score of 85 on the internet-based examination with a sub-score of 26 for speaking or an IELTS exam with a 7.5 overall score, a 7 speaking subscore and all other subscores above a 6.5.

- The University of Tulsa cannot guarantee that completion of the baccalaureate program of nursing will enable a graduate to take the National Council of State Boards of Nursing Licensure Examination.







- Once matriculated into the TU BSN program, students cannot progress within a level or to the next level without successfully completing prior courses with a grade of C or higher in Nursing Major Requirements.
- A student who receives a grade below C in any nursing major or nursing foundation course is dismissed
  from the program but may reapply for admission to the program. If a student leaves the nursing program for
  more than six semesters (excluding summers), the student must retake all nursing courses beginning with
  the second semester sophomore courses, if readmitted.
