To comply with this agreement, students must complete the associate degree with the major listed above and include the specific courses listed below.

Courses listed here are required for the agreement. Credited courses completed as part of the A.S. that do not apply to general education requirements at TCC or the OCU major transfer to OCU as electives.

An Associate of Science (AS) degree from an accredited Oklahoma institution with a minimum of 60 semester hours completed will be admitted to Oklahoma City University as having completed their general education requirements, with the following exceptions:

- Students must complete a Religion course at OCU (REL 1003 or REL 1513) if they have not taken an equivalent course. (Equivalent TCC course is included in the degree map below as a TCC Humanities elective requirement).
- Students must complete an approved Service Learning course, which will be fulfilled by OCU's NURS 4104 Community Health Nursing.
- Because of the time commitment required of BSN Nursing students enrolled in OCU Nursing (NURS) courses, it is recommended that students complete all OCU required electives while at TCC. See "Year Two, Semester Three (Summer)" in Transfer Map for details.

 - TCC students on this plan should apply to the OCU BSN Program during Year Two Semester Four at TCC.(<u>Transfer Application Instructions |</u> <u>Oklahoma City University (okcu.edu)</u>. Students will be notified if they meet OCU's BSN program admission requirements during Year Two Semester Five, prior to the Fall start date of the program.
- Year Two Semester Four at TCC: Be sure to apply for graduation! (<u>Graduation & Commencement | TCC: Tulsa Community College (tulsacc.edu)</u>.
- Transcripts: Submit an official TCC transcript to OCU (<u>Student Records | TCC: Tulsa Community College (tulsacc.edu)</u>.
- Reverse Transfer: If you have not earned an Associate in Science from TCC, and have completed 60 credit hours, with 15 of those hours completed at TCC, contact <u>reversetransfer@tulsacc.edu</u> to see if you qualify for a degree through the Reverse Transfer Program.

Additional Program Information:

- Oklahoma City University will accept traditional or online courses for transfer with the
 exception of lab science, foreign language, and public speaking. Foreign language and
 public speaking courses must be completed in traditional course format for the credit to
 transfer. Lab science courses can be either in-person or hybrid; hybrid science courses
 must have the lab component completed in-person.
- All transfer courses *beyond the required 60 hours* for TCC's A.S. degree must be completed with a C or better. Specific courses with a minimum grade requirement for admission to the BSN Program are shown below.
- The OCU BSN program is full-time with 3-4 semesters of clinical coursework.
- TCC courses should be taken in the order they are planned to ensure that students can progress in OCU coursework as planned in this degree map.
- OCU BSN program admission requirements differ for the traditional and accelerated options due to the rigor of the 12-month accelerated schedule. <u>BSN Program</u> <u>Information | Oklahoma City University (okcu.edu)</u>
- Oklahoma City University cannot guarantee that completion of the BSN nursing program will enable a graduate to take the National Council of State Boards of Nursing Licensure Examination.
- Concurrent enrollment at another institution must be approved by the student's academic dean. Matriculated students at OCU can only take 12 hours at another institution.

Once matriculated into the OCU BSN Program, students are required to adhere to all
progression, dismissal, and withdrawal policies outlined in the OCU Nursing Student
