1. Completion of ENGL 2543 and ENGL 2653 at TCC may substitute for ENGL 2463 and ENGL 2243 on the TU side, increasing the number of general elective credits for the bachelor degree program by 6 credit hours.
2. If students choose not to pursue the Creative Writing specialty after matriculating into TU, ENGL 2493 will count as a general elective and one general elective on the TU side will be replaced by another Major Elective course.
3. Recommended languages on TCC side are limited to French, Spanish and American Sign Language. Selection of a different language could increase the overall credit hours for completion, depending on how many free elective credits are still available after graduating from TCC. Discuss the best option for planning your foreign language courses with your academic advisor or send questions to the TU Center for Academic Advising.

1. No more than nine hours in ENGL may be earned in addition to the indicated major subject requirements. This number may be exceeded only by increasing the number of hours beyond the 120 required for graduation.
2. Students may choose to specialize in either Literature or Creative Writing. Major electives must be at the 3000-level or 4000-level. Upper-level English courses are assigned one or more “tags” designating them as Creation (C), Diversity (D), Early (E), and/or Media and Genre (M). Students select “tagged” electives according to their specialization. After counting ENGL 2493 on the TCC towards the Creation major elective requirement, below is a breakdown of the remaining tags by specialty track.
 - a. Literature Specialization = 1 D, 1 E, and 5 other upper level major electives.
 - b. Creative Writing Specialization = 3 C, 1 D, 1 E, and 2 other upper-level major electives.

TCC Milestones and Recommended Actions:

- **Consider Summer Courses:** Summer courses at TCC can help accelerate your time to transfer, and help you stay on track. Talk to your advisor about planning summer courses.
- **During or After Year One at TCC:** Consider a campus tour of University of Tulsa and connect with a TU academic advisor, to ensure you are on track to transfer. Your TCC academic advisor can assist in planning these actions.
- **During Year Two at TCC:** During semester three coursework (or two semesters before you plan to transfer if attending part-time), apply for admission at University of Tulsa as a transfer student (<https://admission.utulsa.edu/apply/transfer-applicants/>).
- **Final Semester at TCC:** Congratulations you are about to earn your Associate Degree! Be sure to apply for graduation @ <https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation>.
- **Transcripts:** After your final semester, submit an official TCC transcript to TU (www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/student-records/requesting-and-submitting-transcripts).
- **Reverse Transfer:** Students who transfer to a university before completing an associate degree and who have earned at least 15 credit hours from TCC may be eligible to complete their TCC degree through Reverse Transfer. Email reversetransfer@tulsacc.edu to see if you qualify for a degree through the Reverse Transfer program (<https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation/reverse-transfer>).

University Program Notes and Information:

- **TU Tuition Costs:** Full-time students pay a flat tuition rate each semester they are enrolled in 12 - 18 hours. Any semester where a student is enrolled in 11 hours or less is billed per semester hour. Any semesters with an approved overload above 18 hours has additional tuition costs on top of the flat tuition rate to cover the additional hours. Tuition costs and associated student fees are posted online at Tuition & Costs - The University of Tulsa (utulsa.edu). The degree map above has been divided to maximum enrollment versus tuition cost each semester. Students that choose to enroll in fewer than 12 hours or more than 18 hours in any particular semester should be prepared for different tuition costs.
- Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 in the Area of Concentration (Major and Minor subjects) and a minimum of 2.0 TU GPA.
- No Pass/D/F or CLEP credit may be applied toward the Area of Concentration.
- Students must complete a Minor subject.
- Courses applied to meet Core and General Curriculum requirements may not also apply in your Major or Minor subjects.

- Two thirds of the course work in the Major subject must be at the 3000 or 4000 level.
- TU will waive the following courses FYE 1001 required for degree completion if student follows the mapped courses. However if the student doesn't follow the course map as outlined they could be required to take FYE 1001.
