TRANSFER AND ARTICULATION AGREEMENT  
MISSOURI SOUTHERN STATE UNIVERSITY  
AND TULSA COMMUNITY COLLEGE

***Purpose***

This agreement is to facilitate the transfer of students between the Tulsa Community College Associate in Arts in Sociology and Missouri Southern State University Bachelor of Arts in Sociology.

***Terms***

- The agreed upon two plus two programs apply to the Bachelor of Arts in Sociology.
- The agreed upon two plus two courses taken at Tulsa Community College and Missouri Southern are identified in the Transfer Guide addendum.
- The Bachelor of Arts in Sociology regulations for accreditation are met by courses in this agreement at Tulsa Community College and Missouri Southern State University.
- MSSU's current national accreditation through the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) is supported by this agreement and the maintenance of competencies and course standards at Tulsa Community College.
- Tulsa Community College Sociology AA students with a 2.00 grade point average may apply in the usual timeline to the MSSU BA in Sociology program.

***Duration, Notice of Change or Cancellation***

This agreement is for a period of 6 years effective Fall 2024 through Summer 2030 and will be re-evaluated at the end of this period.

Program requirements may change with catalog updates.

Either institution may cancel this agreement by notifying the other no less than one academic year before the indented date of change or cancellation.

***Scholarship opportunities for U.S. citizens or permanent residents enrolled full-time at MSSU include:***

- \$1,500 merit-based Dean's Scholarship for students who transfer with a 3.0-3.24 GPA.

*Starting Catalog Year 2024-2025*

- \$4,500 merit-based President's Distinguished Scholarship for students who transfer with a 3.25-3.49 GPA.
- \$6,000 merit-based Board of Governors Distinguished Scholarship for students who transfer with a 3.5-4.0 GPA.

***Scholarship opportunities for Non-US Citizens enrolled full-time at MSSU include:***

- \$5,500 merit-based MOSO International Achievement Scholarship for students who transfer with a 3.0GPA.
