TCC Milestones and Recommended Actions:

- **Consider Summer Courses:** Summer courses at TCC can help accelerate your time to transfer, and help you stay on track. Talk to your advisor about planning summer courses.
- **During or After Year One at TCC:** Consider a campus tour of OU-Tulsa and connect with an OU-Tulsa academic advisor, to ensure you are on track to transfer. Your TCC academic advisor can assist in planning these actions.
- **During Year Two at TCC:** During or right after semester three coursework, apply for admission at OU-Tulsa as a transfer student (<https://www.ou.edu/tulsa/apply>).
- **Final Semester at TCC:** Congratulations you are about to earn your Associate Degree! Be sure to apply for graduation @ <https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation>.
- **Transcripts:** After your final semester, submit an official TCC transcript to OU (www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/student-records/requesting-and-submitting-transcripts).
- **Reverse Transfer:** Students who transfer to a university before completing an associate degree and who have earned at least 15 credit hours from TCC may be eligible to complete their TCC degree through Reverse Transfer. Email reversetransfer@tulsacc.edu to see if you qualify for a degree through the Reverse Transfer program (<https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation/reverse-transfer>).

OU Social Work Program Notes and Information:

- The College of Arts & Sciences requires 6 hours of Upper-Division General Education humanities outside of the major department.
- Students must complete a minimum of 60 hours at a four-year institution.
- Students must complete a minimum of 30 hours at OU, 15 of which must be upper-division major courses.

1. College of Arts & Sciences Requirements:

- a) Humanities is defined as any course selected from Understanding Artistic Forms, Western Civilization or Non-Western Civilization. These upper-division elective requirements must be from outside of the student's major.
- b) A natural physical science is any that comes from one of the following departments: AGSC, ASTR, CHEM, GEOG, GEOL, GPHY, METR, or PHYS.
- c) The Anne & Henry Zarrow School of Social work requires that students maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA during the course of study. Students must have a 2.5 to graduate from the program.

2. College of Arts & Science Foreign Language Requirement:

- a) Students must complete a minimum of one credit hour at the intermediate (2000) level in any foreign language. Students who have not completed this requirement may petition to have the requirement waived if they have completed at least 12 hours in a single foreign language. Otherwise, students must meet the requirement with either a combination of TCC and OU coursework or entirely at OU.
- b) Beginning with catalog year 2022-2023, the following TCC course sequences will meet the OU CAS 0-13 hour requirement for foreign language:
 - i. French: FREN 1103, 1213, 2113, & 2213
 - ii. Spanish: SPAN 1103, 1213, 2113, & 2143
 - iii. American Sign Language: ASLE 1363, 1373, 2414
 - iv. Japanese: JAPN 1103, 1213, 2113, 2213
- c) Students may use the CLEP exam to meet this requirement. In order to do so, the student must take the national CLEP exam and pass with a minimum score of:
 - i. French – 59
 - ii. German – 63
 - iii. Spanish – 63

1. Anne & Henry Zarrow School of Social Work Pre-Requisites:

- a) The Anne & Henry Zarrow School of Social work requires five pre-requisites for the Social Work major: SOC 1113, PSY 1113, S WK 2113, S WK 2223, and BIOL 1005.
- b) Students must complete these courses with a grade of C or higher.
- c) Students who have completed BIOL 1005 (or a similar equivalent) may be eligible for pre-program admission into the School with the condition that they will complete the other pre-requisites at OU.
