- **Transcripts:** Submit an official TCC transcript to NWOSU (<u>www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/student-records/requesting-and-submitting-transcripts</u>).
- **Reverse Transfer:** Students who transfer to a university before completing an associate degree and who have earned at least 15 credit hours from TCC may be eligible to complete their TCC degree through Reverse Transfer. #### **University Program Notes and Information:**

 In accordance with the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, Northwestern Oklahoma State University fully participates in the articulation policy for the transfer of students among Oklahoma public institutions. A student transferring to Northwestern with an Associate of Arts or an Associate of Science degree from an Oklahoma accredited institution will be considered to have completed the general education requirements of the baccalaureate degree. (Note: exceptions are teacher education, certain professional programs, and specific requirements of certain majors and minors.) (from NWOSU Undergraduate Catalog)

## TULSA COMMUNITY COLLEGE PROGRAM ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Northwestern Oklahoma State University and Tulsa Community College (TCC) accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools, mutually enter into this articulation agreement to provide students with the educational opportunity to complete an Associate in Arts in English at Tulsa Community College which will serve as the first two years of a Bachelor of Arts in English degree at the Northwestern Oklahoma State University.

In accordance with the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education policy 3.11, this agreement will be subject to the following provisions:

- 1. The student shall have graduated from Tulsa Community College (TCC) with an **Associate in Arts** degree with a total of **61** credit hours (excluding zero-level classes and physical education activity courses).
- The student shall earn a minimum of 60 credit hours at the Northwestern Oklahoma State University, excluding physical education activity courses, of which 40 semester hours must be in 3000/4000 level courses.
- 3. The courses in the **Associate in Arts** degree at Tulsa Community College outlined in the following pages will be accepted as satisfying the general education and computer proficiency requirements for the **Bachelor of Arts** at **Northwestern Oklahoma State University.**
- 4. Provided the student follows the sequence of both the associate degree program and the baccalaureate degree program, the student will be able to complete the baccalaureate degree program in **121** credit hours, the same number as required for a native student.
- 5. The student shall have earned a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale (an average grade of "C" or better) at Tulsa Community College.
- 6. TCC and **Northwestern Oklahoma State University** will cooperatively develop course-to-course equivalencies, transfer guides, and degree plans necessary for each student to progress from the associate degree through the baccalaureate degree.
- 7. Each institution is committed to providing a seamless education path for the students in the A.A. English program and to enhancing this partnership.
- 8. Each institution will consult the other institution when considering curriculum changes which will impact this articulation agreement.

The student shall submit an application for admission to both institutions. The student must submit an official copy of their Tulsa Community College transcript to **Northwestern Oklahoma State University** once TCC courses have been completed. The **Northwestern Oklahoma State University** office of admissions will formally notify the student of his/her admission status to the University.

Upon formal approval of this articulation agreement by the appropriate officials of the two institutions, each is free to publicize the terms herein. This agreement shall remain in effect until one or all of the institutions deem it necessary to modify or terminate the agreement.
